2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1

13 But just as we have the same spirit of faith that is in accordance with scripture—"I believed, and so I spoke"—we also believe, and so we speak, 14 because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus, and will bring us with you into his presence. 15 Yes, everything is for your sake, so that grace, as it extends to more and more people, may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God. 16 So we do not lose heart. Even though our outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed day by day. 17 For this slight momentary affliction is preparing us for an eternal weight of glory beyond all measure, 18 because we look not at what can be seen but at what cannot be seen; for what can be seen is temporary, but what cannot be seen is eternal. 1 For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

Hearing Assistance Device Instructions

Step 1: Make sure the headphones or loop are plugged into the headphone jack located on the right side of the device.

Step 2: Turn the grey dial to the left. The dial should click and a red light (located above the white label "A Channel") should come on. If the red light does not come on please ask an usher for assistance.

Step 3: Place headphones over ears, or loop around neck. Device can be clipped to pants or other straps located on your person.

Step 4: adjust the volume by turning the grey dial.

Volume up = turn to the left

Volume down = turn to the right

*Hearing assist devices will only pick up sound that is projected through our sound system (i.e. through a microphone, speakers, music players, etc.).

If further assistance is needed, please find an usher or UUMC staff member and they would be happy to help you.
