Mark 6:30-34, 53-56

30 The apostles gathered around Jesus, and told him all that they had done and taught. 31 He said to them, "Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. 32 And they went away in the boat to a deserted place by themselves. 33 Now many saw them going and recognized them, and they hurried there on foot from all the towns and arrived ahead of them. 34 As he went ashore, he saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

53 When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret and moored the boat. 54 When they got out of the boat, people at once recognized him, 55 and rushed about that whole region and began to bring the sick on mats to wherever they heard he was. 56 And wherever he went, into villages or cities or farms, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged him that they might touch even the fringe of his cloak; and all who touched it were healed.

In The Neighborhood Initiative

Who will decide how the ITNI funds will be used each year?

As we learned last week, 6% of the interest earned on the In the Neighborhood endowment will be used to fund ITNI programs annually, including for things such as program curriculum, supplies, specific equipment needs, etc. Specific ITNI programming will be proposed each year by the ITNI Taskforce and the UUMC Neighborhood Coordinator. The proposed programming will complement programs already in place at UUMC. The proposal, which will

include a budget for the year, will be brought to the Endowment Committee for review and approval to ensure it aligns with the mission and goals of the ITNI, "to become 'one neighborhood' by embracing the beauty, diversity and unique strengths and challenges within our collective neighborhood through the talents, knowledge, and experience of all neighbors. Together, in partnership with one another, we empower and equip our community with opportunities for education, economic stability and spiritual wellbeing." Once approved by the Endowment Committee, the proposal will be brought to the church Charge Conference to be voted on by the church at large.

So in essence, it is the church - UUMC - that will decide how the ITNI funds are used each year.
