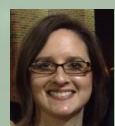

5 which comes forth like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and runs its course with joy like a strong man.

6 **Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them; and there is nothing hid from its heat.**

7 The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul; **the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple;**

8 the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart;

the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes;

9 the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever;

the ordinances of the Lord are true, and righteous altogether.

10 More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold;

sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.

11 Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

12 **But who can understand one's own errors? Clear me from hidden faults.**

13 Also keep your servant from the insolent; let them not have dominion over me!

Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.

14 **Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.**
